Erosive skin

1. Case study description

patient age	70 years
gender	male
diagnosis	actinic keratosis (skin cancer)
treatment	3 weeks twice daily application of 5-Fluorouracil
therapy after care	after 3 weeks start ALHYDRAN

3. Conclusions medical team

- ALHYDRAN is easy to apply to mildly erosive skin
- ALHYDRAN is a pleasant alternative to fusidic acid cream
- ALHYDRAN does not entail a risk of bacterial resistance, unlike fusidic acid cream
